

## Final Tech Guidelines for Niagara PCA Driver Education

Niagara PCA will provide a Final Tech inspection in the morning of the first day of each Driver Education event. Cars will be checked for loose items, fluid leaks, fluid caps secured, torqued lug nuts, run group decal and car numbers applied, and any other concerns of track worthiness.

**BE SURE TO REGISTER, EMPTY YOUR CAR, AND APPLY YOUR DECALS PRIOR TO ENTERING THE TECH LINE!**

**Instructors:** Have the option to self-tech your own car. If you do not feel comfortable self-teching your own car, please bring it through the tech line. Instructors are also encouraged to tech your student's car. This gives you the opportunity to build rapport with your student, as well as to preview their car and tailor your instruction based on their car's track prep. Please find and consult your student early in the morning to discuss their final tech.

**Students:** (Those drivers who are assigned an instructor) Must have your car final teched either by your instructor, or through the tech line as provided by Niagara PCA. Please find and consult your instructor early in the morning to discuss your final tech. If you do not have your car tech inspected either by your instructor or by proceeding through the tech line, you will not be allowed on the track.

**Solo Drivers:** (Those drivers who are not assigned an instructor) Must take your car through the tech line as provided by Niagara PCA. If you do not get your car final teched you will not be allowed on the track.
